Venous leg ulceration.

SUMMARY:

- 78 year old
- Venous Leg Ulcer June 06.
- Healed week 7

PATIENT INFORMATION: 78 year old female.

A 78 year old female patient has a history of venous ulceration from June 06.

Un-compliance to compression bandaging, gradual compression introduced.

Ulcer eventually healed but then reopened deteriorated with infection. Ulcer exudating heavily and patient redressing at home.

On commencing cycloidal vibration therapy (VIBRO-PULSE $^{\text{TM}}$), ulcer on the left ankle as above.

Cycloidal Vibration Therapy (VIBRO-PULSE™): started once or twice x a day for 30 minutes per treatment. Patient self administered the treatment.

EXUDATE: quickly significantly reduced.

WEEK 7 of VIBRO-PULSE™:

WOUND: The leg ulcer healed to form very small scabbed area.

SATISFACTION: Patient happy with outcome and progress.

EST. COST example: Ulcer dressed once a week from August 06 to commencing VIBRO-PULSE = £6760.

To heal using VIBRO-PULSE: twice a day: = £457. plus weekly dressing change = £364

Drug Tariff part IXA (average product prices) Average dressing and compression bandaging + materials= £14.00 Skin care cleaning material, gloves apron, associated materials = £3.00 Total = £17
